Purdue NSF I-Corps Site Team Grant Application

Please read the following role descriptions for I-Corps team members.

Entrepreneurial Lead(s) (*EL*) – a student (undergraduate or graduate), post-doctoral scholar, faculty, professional staff, or community/regional individual who have a passion and commitment for moving ideas to impact and have a technology that they want to commercialize.

Mentor (*M*) – typically an entrepreneur-in-residence, but can also be someone who brings knowledge and experience of the relevant commercial field such as faculty, alumni, professional staff, or local and regional entrepreneurs.

Academic Lead (*AL*) – teams considering subsequent application to the NSF National I-Corps programs should have a member with an academic appointment that would normally qualify them to submit proposals or play the role of a PI in subsequent submissions to NSF. Exceptions can be made with the approval of the I-Corps Site Director.
