

Requirements for Upper Division

For the following Majors:

- Economics

You must have completed all of your EAI courses with a minimum EAI GPA of a 2.75 or higher. Your overall cumulative GPA must be a 2.5 or higher.

The courses that make up your EAI are outlined below. Your EAI courses are based on the first semester you started at Purdue. We call this your catalog term.

Other requirements:

- For students who start at Purdue, the EAI must consist of at least (2) School of Business graded courses (for Economics ECON 25100 & ECON 25200) or (3) Purdue graded EAI courses.
- Course Re-take allowance of MAI/EAI courses depends on the number of courses taken at Purdue and/or DSOB, no more than 2 or 3 MAI/EAI courses (or their equivalents) may be taken two times each for a grade. See our **retake policy** to determine your eligibility.
- Must not be on academic probation
- C- or higher in any EAI courses
- C- or higher in ECON courses taken prior to Upper Division
