

# Requirements for Upper Division

For the following Majors:

- Accounting
- Business Analytics & Information Management (*After Fall 2022*)
- Finance
- General Management
- Marketing
- Supply Chain Information & Analytics (*Prior to 2022*)
- Supply Chain & Operations Management (*After Fall 2022*)

You must have completed all of your MAI courses with a minimum MAI GPA of a 3.0 or higher. Your overall cumulative GPA must be a 2.5 or higher.

The courses that make up your MAI are outlined below. Your MAI courses are based on the first semester you started at Purdue. We call this your catalog term.

Other requirements:

- For students who start at Purdue, the MAI must consist of at least (2) School of Business graded courses (MGMT 20000 & ECON 25100) or (3) Purdue graded MAI courses
- Course Re-take allowance of MAI/EAI courses depends on the number of courses taken at Purdue and/or DSOB, no more than 2 or 3 MAI/EAI courses (or their equivalents) may be taken two times each for a grade. See our [retake policy](#) to determine your eligibility.
- Must not be on academic probation
- C- or higher in any MAI courses
- C- or higher in MGMT, ECON, OBHR (MEO) courses taken prior to Upper Division
