This program will help teachers learn about economic concepts that help to explain why people value health insurance, the challenges involved in providing health insurance, and what has been going on in health care reform. Presenter: **Dr. Tim Moore** is the Director of the Purdue Center for Economic Education Director and an Associate Professor of Economics at Purdue. He teaches health economics and conducts research into related topics, including how income affects health, disability insurance, and the economics of illicit drug markets.

Lessons Discussion: **Dr. Kelly Blanchard** will complement Dr. Moore's presentation with an overview of classroom applications that focus on the economics of insurance markets. Interactive activities and games will highlight the challenges inherent in insurance markets. Dr. Blanchard is an associate director of the PCEE. She is a lecturer in the economics department and has been teaching students at Purdue for almost 20 years.
