Management Admissions Index (MAI)

- To be automatically admitted into upper division, students who have completed all courses in the MAI must have at least a 3.00 MAI GPA and a 2.50 cumulative GPA, have a "C" or higher in all MAI and School of Management courses and may not be on probation. Students with at least a 2.75 MAI GPA who meet all of the requirements listed above will be reviewed by the Faculty Undergraduate Admissions Committee to determine admission into upper division.
- MAI courses, or their equivalents, may only be enrolled in two times for a grade.
- A maximum of three MAI courses may be retaken.
- Math courses numbered below your highest level of recorded achievement may not be retaken.
- School of Management, MAI, concentration and minor courses in which you earn an "F" can only be retaken at Purdue University, West Lafayette.
- Previous enrollments in MA 16100,16200,16500,16600 do not count against the retake policy if a Change Of Degree Objective occurs.
